VII. Draft 2024-2033 STIP Update

The 2022 Appropriations Act (SFY 2023 Budget for the State of NC) was signed into law on July 11th. This budget includes a provision dedicating a portion of the state's sales tax revenue to the Highway Trust Fund, which increases the amount of funding available in the 2024-2033 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). After NCDOT calculates the increased revenue forecast, it will reprogram the Draft 2024-2033 STIP. While the additional funding will not overcome all of the cost increases and estimating issues that led to the proposed changes in the 2024-2033 draft STIP, it will help to lessen the impact of those issues.

As a result of this increase in revenue and reprogramming of projects, NCDOT announced on July 13th that the deadline for "swapping projects" will be delayed. The TCC had already recommended that the RPO not make any "swaps" at its July 12th meeting. However, we will wait until the new revenue forecast has been incorporated into the Draft STIP before the TAC makes the final decision on swapping projects.

VIII. Selection of TAC Board Member of the Year

The LRCOG will recognize the TAC Board Member of the Year at its Annual Meeting on Thursday, October 20th, 2022. This award is selected through a vote of the TAC members. Members will receive an email with the information for submitting their ballot.

WELCOME AND READING OF ETHICS AWARENESS REMINDER/ PUBLIC COMMENTS

The roll was called; a quorum was present. Chairperson Faline Dial called the meeting to order at 12:01 p.m. and read the Ethics Awareness and Conflict of Interest Reminder. She asked for Public Comments; there was no one present to speak.

CONSIDERATION OF MINUTES FROM JANUARY 24, 2022 TAC MINUTES

Mr. Bill Bayless made a motion, seconded by Mr. Tim Ivey to approve the January 24, 2022 TAC minutes as presented. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

<u>Presentation: Safety Data Trends in Lumber River RPO and Statewide</u>

Mr. Brian Murphy, NCDOT Safety Planning Engineer presented information regarding safety data for the Lumber River RPO.

Presentation: Draft 2024-2033 State Transportation Improvement Program

The Draft 2024-2033 State Transportation Improvement Program was released on 4/25/22. Ms. Robertson gave a presentation on how the Draft was developed. The Draft is a subset of projects from the current 2020-2029 STIP. Because the current STIP is over programmed,

none of the new project submittals from P6.0 were considered. Projects in the current STIP that are scheduled for construction by 2026 or have Right-of-Way acquisition underway were programmed first. The remaining projects were then programmed based on their scores from the previous prioritization cycles until the STI budge categories was filled.

The Lumber River RPO portion of the STIP was shown in Attachment 1 of the Agenda Packet. Thirteen Highway projects currently funded in the 2020-2029 STIP are not funded in the Draft 2024-2033 STIP. One Highway and two Aviation projects had most of their funding removed: only Preliminary Engineering is funded. Four Highway projects and one Pedestrian project had their construction dates delayed by one year.

NCDOT is allowing a "Flexibility Option" with this Draft. Projects that aren't selected for funding can be swapped with projects that are funded following certain parameters. Project swapping will be discussed at the July meeting; the deadline for requesting swaps is September 30, 2022.

<u>Consideration of 4th Quarter Amendment to the 2021-22 Planning Work Program</u>

Janet presented the following draft amendments to the 2021-2022 Planning Work Program:

- Funds in the amount of \$3,000 are being transferred out of <u>Item II-2 Prioritization</u> because the P6.0 Prioritization process was halted in the fall of 2021.
- Funds in the amount of \$1,000 are being transferred out of <u>Item II-3 Program and Project Development</u> because there has been less activity in this line item than anticipated.
- Funds in the amount of \$4,000 are being transferred out of <u>Item IV-1 Programmatic Direct</u> Charges because expenditures have been less than expected.
- Funds in the amount of \$3,000 are being transferred out of <u>Item V-1 Indirect Costs</u> because expenditures have been less than expected.
- Funds in the amount of \$1,000 are being transferred into <u>Item I-1 Data Collection and</u> Assessment because there has been more activity in this line item than expected.
- Funds in the amount of \$1,500 are being transferred into <u>Item II-1 Comprehensive</u> Transportation Plan Development because activity has been higher than expected.
- Funds in the amount of \$5,500 are being transferred into <u>Item II-4 General Transportation</u> <u>Planning</u> because staff has been involved in more regional and statewide committees and additional GIS training.
- Funds in the amount of \$3,000 are being transferred into <u>III-1 Administrative Activities</u> because activity has been higher than anticipated.

At its May 10, 2022 meeting, the Transportation Coordinating Committee recommended approval of this amendment to the 2021-2022 PWP.

Motion was made by Mr. Elbert Gibson and seconded by Mr. Tim Ivey to approve the 4th Quarter Amendments to the 2021-2022 Planning Work Program as presented. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Consideration of FY 2022-23 Planning Work Program

Ms. Robertson presented the FY 2022-23 Planning Work Program to the Committee. She advised that the funding level remains the same as FY 2021-22. She informed the committee that the LRCOG's cost allocation Plan for FY 2022-23 has not been finalized so the amount shown in Indirect costs is an estimate. At its May 10, 2022, the Transportation Coordinating Committee recommended approval of the 2022-23 PWP.

Motion was made by Mr. Bill Bayless and seconded by Mr. Elbert Gibson to approve the 2022-2023 Planning Work Program as presented. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Election of Chairman and Vice-Chairman

Ms. Robertson advised the Committee that it was time to hold officer elections. She stated that the TAC By-laws state that officers may serve two consecutive one-year terms. The current Chair and Vice-chair have each served one term.

<u>Motion was made by Mr. Bill Bayless and seconded by Mr. Elbert Gibson to re-appoint Faline</u>

<u>Dial as Chairman and Tim Ivey as Vice-Chairman. There were no other nominations made.</u>
