# VI. Consideration of 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Amendment to the 2021-22 Planning Work Program

Attachment 3 contains a draft amendment to the FY 2020-21 Planning Work Program (PWP)

- Funds in the amount of \$3,000 are being transferred out of <u>Item II-2 Prioritization</u> because the P6.0 Prioritization process was halted in the fall of 2021.
- Funds in the amount of \$1,000 are being transferred out of <u>Item II-3 Program and Project Development</u> because there has been less activity in this line item than anticipated.
- Funds in the amount of \$4,000 are being transferred out of <u>Item IV-1 Programmatic</u> <u>Direct Charges</u> because expenditures have been less than expected.
- Funds in the amount of \$3,000 are being transferred out of <u>Item V-1 Indirect Costs</u> because expenditures have been less than expected.
- Funds in the amount of \$1,000 are being transferred into <u>Item I-1 Data Collection and Assessment</u> because there has been more activity in this line item than expected.
- Funds in the amount of \$1,500 are being transferred into <u>Item II-1 Comprehensive</u> <u>Transportation Plan Development</u> because activity has been higher than expected.
- Funds in the amount of \$5,500 are being transferred into <u>Item II-4 General</u>
  <u>Transportation Planning</u> because staff has been involved in more regional and statewide committees and additional GIS training.
- Funds in the amount of \$3,000 are being transferred into *III-1 Administrative Activities* because activity has been higher than anticipated.

<u>Requested Action:</u> Recommend Approval of this FY 2021-22 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Amendment to the Transportation Advisory Committee

#### **Draft 2022-23 Planning Work Program**

Janet Robertson advised the committee that the Draft Planning Work Program for FY 22-23 is due to NCDOT by February 25, 2022. She stated that the funding level will be the same as the current fiscal year. If any member would like to propose a project in its area, Ms. Robertson requested that they please notify her promptly.

<u>Motion was made by Mr. John Massey and seconded by Mr. Charles Nichols to recommend approval of the Draft Planning Work Program to the Transportation Advisory Committee as presented.</u> The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

#### INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

Janet Robertson discussed the following items with the Committee:

#### Status of STIP process- Prioritization 6.0 scoring

Because the P6 scoring process was halted after quantitative scoring of projects, the future 2024-2033 STIP will consist of a subset of existing projects in the current 2020-2029 STIP. None of the new projects that were proposed in P6.0 will be considered.

<u>Delivery Projects</u> - Projects with current let dates in fiscal year 2026 or sooner, or are wholly or partially funded with grants, or have full right-of-way authorization, will remain in the future 2024-2033 STIP.

At the Board of Transportation meeting in February, the Board will decide which of the remaining projects that aren't in the above category will be included in the 2024-33 STIP.

#### Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act

On November 15, 2021 President Biden signed the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act into Law. The bipartisan legislation provides \$973 Billion over five years from FY 22 through FY 26. This includes \$550 Billion in new funding (the remainder is authorization of funding for various existing baseline programs). \$284 Billion of the "new funding is specifically for transportation, while the other \$266 Billion is for water, broadband, energy/power, environmental remediation, western water infrastructure, and resiliency.

The \$284 Billion in new transportation funding is split out as follows:

- \$66 Billion for rail
- \$39 Billion for transit
- \$25 Billion for airports
- \$17 Billion for ports and airways
- \$15 Billion for electric vehicle infrastructure
- \$11 Billion for safety
- \$ 1 Billion for reconnecting communities

\$110 Billion for roads and bridges — NC will receive approximately \$7.7 Billion over five years for highways and bridges. In NC there are 1,460 bridges and over 3,116 miles of highway in poor condition. Since 2011, commute times have increased by 10.7% in NC and on average, each driver pays \$500 per year in costs due to driving on roads in need of repair. The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law is the single largest dedicated bridge investment since the construction of the interstate highway system.

NC can also compete for a Federal Highway \$12.5 Billion competitive grant program for nationally significant bridges and other bridges
